GRIFFYDAM SENIOR SCHOOL

Griffydam School opened in 1915 for pupils aged 5-14 years. Children from Griffydam, Newbold, Coleorton, Peggs Green, Swannington, Thringstone and Osgathorpe attended the school. Pupils could transfer to the grammar school in Coalville at 11 years if they passed an exam. The Head Teacher from 1928 to 1948 was Mr Elcock see photo.

In 1939, the school accommodated evacuees from Birmingham and London see chart. After 1948, pupils aged 11 and over were

In 1954, the 59 pupils moved back to the former infant school on Top Road. The senior school continued as an annexe to Coalville Grammar School until 1962.
